Medical Beds & 21 Mattresses and also 100 boxed Rough Terrain Wheelchairs. then on Saturday, members, Rotary friends and Rotarians from other clubs started packing these into a 40 ft high container which will be shipped to Ba Hospital, Lautoka next month. Included in the container are Emergency stretchers and medical supplies. We were able to complete 75% of the container packing last Saturday and the final pack will be Saturday 1 February. If we are able to have at least 6 members and or volunteers at RARE that day then the container packing should be easily completed by mid-morning. This project is another great example of how clubs can work together to assist needy communities; it clearly demonstrates "The Magic of Rotary" and Rotary People of Action
